In this short passage we'll see what happens when God speaks to Moses.

Questions for before you read:

- Have you ever heard from God?
- How does God talk to us? (Prayer, His word, through others)
- What do you know about Moses?



READ

Exodus 3:1-10

ASK

- *What happens to Moses?*
- *What would you do if a burning bush talked to you?*
- *How does Moses respond to God?*

READ

Exodus 3:11-14

ASK

- *What does God say when Moses gets scared?*
- *God is always also with you too. (Matthew 28:20) How does that make you feel? Do you live like that's true?*

PRAY

Lord We thank you for who you are- A God of salvation- The Great Rescuer- Our Comforter. We confess that we sometimes feel like Moses. We are often scared and afraid of life brings us. You tell us that you are always with us- Help us to truly believe that you are always with us. You did great works through Moses and we believe that you will do great things through us.

Characters

Moses- Israelite man that lived as royalty in Egypt (Prince of Egypt) and then fled to live in Midian when he learned that he was an Israelite. At this point in the story Moses is running from his responsibility.

Jethro- Moses's father-in-law. He Employed Moses as a Shepherd.

Pharaoh- King of Egypt that grew up with Moses.

God-God calls himself this in this passage:

I am that I am-
Hebrew- אֶהְיֶה אֲשֶׁר אֶהְיֶה,
"ehyeh 'ăšer 'ehyeh"

God says that Moses can call him "I am who am" This can also be translated as "I am what I am" or "I will be what I will be" or even "I create what I create"

God says this because He is showing how much bigger He is than words. He is so much more than the typical gods of the Egyptians.
